

Housing Hosts

a guide to hosting AHEC students

No Obligation

You are not obligated to host a student. When contacted by the AHEC office, the choice of hosting is always yours.

Length of Students' Stay

The average length of a student rotation is 4 weeks. Some students' rotations are 6, 8, or 12 weeks long. When you accept the student, you will be given the dates of the student's rotation.

Your House Rules

Please inform students of the rules you wish for them to follow while in your home (e.g. no smoking, no loud music after 10 p.m.)

Rent Receipt

Students may ask you to sign a form indicating you received their rent payment.

Non-Smoking

AHEC housing sites are non-smoking for owners and students.

Weekends

Most students go home on weekends, but some may stay. If you prefer students not stay on weekends, please notify the AHEC office.

Community Immersion

If you are involved in community activities, please encourage the student to participate with you. Many will want to learn about your community, and it will enhance their overall experience.

Rent Payment

Students should pay rent by the last week of their stay. University of Kentucky and University of Louisville students pay \$100/week. Please do not hesitate to ask for rent from the student.

Food

You are not required to provide meals for the student; however, some hosts enjoy inviting the student to join them for dinner occasionally.

Kitchen

Students may need to use your kitchen—stove, oven, and/or microwave for cooking. Also, they may need refrigerator & pantry space for their own food items.
